

RIDER INSTRUCTIONS

- Signing- on: Friday 2pm till 7pm. Saturday 7.30am till 6pm. Sunday 8am till 10am.
- **IMPORTANT: PITS & SIGNALLING AREA: NO CHILDREN UNDER 16 / NO DOGS ALLOWED / NO SMOKING / NO PUSHCHAIR OR WHEELCHAIR ACCESS**
- The event has an opening gate start once all competitors are on the beach following starter's orders.
- **IMPORTANT:** There is a Site of Special Scientific Interest (SSSI) to the South of the beach. Please do not enter this area at any time - this will be clearly marked. A map will be at signing on and also in the programme. An individual fine may be implemented and a conviction to anyone entering this area by Natural England.
- **IMPORTANT:** Absolutely no person is permitted over the pedestrian barriers. Event staff only will be permitted in this area. Failure to comply with these conditions will result in the rider being excluded from the race and you will be asked to leave.
- **RIDERS PLEASE STAY WITH YOUR BIKE ON THE TRACK - ONLY BIKES WITH RIDERS WILL BE RECOVERED**
- Please adhere to all safety notices and instructions given by AMCA stewards.
- Park in designated areas only – Please see map on website for details
- **Please ask any spectators you bring to keep off the RNLI Access Road at ALL TIMES!**
- **Please do not empty your chemical toilets in the public toilets**
- **Please use bins provided for your litter**
- All competitors will be issued with 3 wristbands at the point of signing on.
- Wristband holders will only be permitted into the pit area.
- If you have a transponder (all mylaps MX transponders work) please bring this along to the event with you and give the number in at signing on. If you do not have a transponder you can hire one for £30 getting £20 back on return of the transponder at the end of racing. If you do not return the transponder you will be invoiced for the retail cost of a new transponder.
- PLEASE NOTE: NO MINI BIKES – You will be asked to leave the site if you are seen on a mini bike
- **Once your machine is in the holding area, this is where it will remain until pre-race. All machines must have a self closing throttle, operational cut out switch, ball end leavers, folding footrests and a chain guard where fitted as standard.**
- **All riders will be issued with a set of race number graphics that must be placed on your machine. Riders will start in accordance to their race number issued.**
- For the Trophies and prizes please see the programme on the day.
- For all prizes to be collected, riders must attend the trophy presentation at Busters, Grand Parade, near the Clock Tower after the racing has finished - times are 7pm Saturday and 4pm Sunday!
- Generators - Can campers please ensure that all generators are switched off by 23:00.
