

North Devon [Atlantic]Classic Scrambles Club

Team Scramble Races Saturday 3rd and Sunday 4th August 2019

for Classic and Twinshock machines

Rules and Regulations

Riders must be 18 years or over

Both competitions will be run over two legs, legs one on Saturday, legs two on Sunday

Teams in both competitions must consist of four riders plus a manager.

Each rider's finishing position will be counted. eg. 1 point for winner, 10 points for finishing 10th ect. Non finishers will collect 45 points. ALL points will count in the results.

In the event of a tie, the winning team will be decided by the best team result in the second leg.

Each team must wear team coloured shirts. This is to aid the spectators to identify the teams.

The number of teams in each competitions will be limited to ten teams [chosen by the race organiser]

Teams must be named and entered by the team managers. Riders in the teams must enter the main two day event for both days and must enter individually.

Choice of starting position on the startline will be decided by drawing pegs by the team managers on the Saturday. The starting positions on Sunday will be decided by reversing the Saturday draw.

Twin-shock teams

Machines must have swinging arm rear suspension, Drum brakes and an aircooled engine.

Classic teams.

Each team must be made up of 2 four-stroke machines and 2 two-stroke machines.

At least one of the machines must have a pre-unit engine.

All machines must have been available to the general public before 1/1/1974.
