

North Devon [Atlantic] Classic Scrambles Club
Teams Scramble, 3rd and 4th August 2019 for Classic and Twin
shock machines
Rules & Regulations

Riders must be aged 18 yrs or over

Both competition will be run over two legs, leg one on Saturday, leg two on Sunday

Teams in both competitions will consist of four riders plus a manager, with each riders finishing position counting, ie. One point for winner, ten points for finishing tenth ect, Non finishers forty five points. ALL points to count in results.

The team with the lowest point total, will be declared the winner, [In the event of a tie, the team with the lowest point score in the second leg, will be declared the winner]

Choice of starting position on the start line will be decided by drawing pegs by the team managers on the Saturday, the starting position on Sunday will be decided by reversing the Saturday draw.

Each team must have a name and wear, team colour shirts, this is to aid the spectators to identify the teams

All riders must enter the main two day event individually, regs will be available at the end of April

Twin shocks

Machines must have swinging arm rear suspension, drum brakes, and air cooled engines.

Classics

Each team must have at least one machine with a Pre/unit engine [separate gearbox, and at least one Pre 65 machine

[NB as well as the large fourstrokes such as BSA, Triumphs, Ariels etc. there are many 2 stroke machine such as Greeves and ALL Villiers powered machines are pre/unit]. All machines must have been available before 1st January 1974.
