7. I will not participate whilst under the influence of alcohol or intoxicating drugs and that I am taking any prescribed medication I will inform the event organiser and seek approval to participate before taking part.

No refunds after the cancellation cut off date without a legitimate reason. If a rider cancels their entry prior to the event then a £1.25 cancellation fee for admin will be charged. The refund will not be processed until after the event. Refunds will be given if the event is cancelled by the Club.

**Behavior:** The officials of the meeting are all volunteers and deserve to be treated with respect. Any rider(s) that abuses any official or ignores their instruction will be excluded from the rest of the meeting and are subject to penalties as defined in the AMCA Rulebook.
