1. I confirm that I understand the nature of the competition I am entering and I am competent to take part.
2. I confirm that any vehicle I use will comply with the regulations and will be safe and fit for use in the competition.
3. Before taking part in the event I will ensure (Unless prohibited) that I have inspected the venue, the track and the facilities and geographical features and that I am satisfied that it is safe for me to compete.
4. I will not take part if I have any doubt about my ability or the safety of the venue.
5. I accept that the competition in motor sport may involve risk of injury or death and agree to take part at my own risk.
6. Before taking part in the event I will read and be bound by and comply with general regulations, any supplement and final instructions issued by the AMCA, the organizers and the circuit owners and the regulatory body.
7. I will not participate whilst under the influence of alcohol or intoxicating drugs and that if I am taking any prescribed medication I will inform the event organiser and seek approval to participate before taking part.

Any rider(s) who abuses any official or ignores their instruction will be excluded from the rest of the meeting and subject to penalties as defined in the AMCA Rulebook. Riders are also responsible for the behaviour of any person attending with them. Their behaviour will also render the rider liable to such action
